2020 Waterless Boat Race Rules

A novelty race in which cars drag boats around the 3/8 mile Dirt Oval
While trying to dislodge the boats of other competitors

BOATS:

- A.** Boat must be fiberglass V bottom Runabout, Walk through windshield or Center console type boat (NO BASS BOATS) must be a minimum length of 14 ft. and a maximum length of 20 ft.
- B.** No rotten boats if your boat is rotten you will not be allowed to compete in the race.
- C.** All brackets, trim, seats, windows, gas tanks and out-drives, out board engine and all drive-train must be removed.
- D.** Boats must be cleaned out and free of all trash.
- E.** No trailers all boats must be dragged.
- F.** Rear transom must be cut in 3 places, right rear corner, left rear corner and the center of transom must be cut all the way down from top to bottom of transom with a reciprocating saw (SAWZALL).
- G.** A three (3) ft Trophy for the all-round best looking boat
(**paint'em , name'em and show'em off**)

BOAT HOOK-UP:

- A.** Boats must be dragged with only 1 cable maximum size of 3/8 inch O.D. (NO CHAINS)
- B.** Boat must be separated a minimum of 8 feet behind tow vehicle.
- C.** May use a 1/2 inch eye bolt with a 4"X4" – 1/4 inch thick metal washer inside the boat, must be in the same place or close to the eye hook that came with the boat. This is the only way you are allowed to stiffen the connection. (No wheels, metal bars, pipes or wood beams are allowed to stiffen the connection)

TOW VEHICLE:

- A.** Any Passenger car, Station Wagon, Standard Pick Up, Van or Street Cruiser allowed.
- B.** A front windshield or mesh screen with bracing is required.
- C.** No working 4x4's if a 4x4 is used you must remove the front drive shaft.
- D.** No jacked-up trucks, jeeps or any other jacked-up vehicles will be allowed.
- E.** Driver must wear seatbelts & helmet.(Eye prepetition recommended)
- F.** Driver only passengers are not allowed.
- G.** A vehicle may only ram a boat, Vehicles MAY NOT ram other vehicles.
